# How to find skin cancer early

To catch it as early as possible—at its most treatable stage, do the **ABCDE** check on suspicious skin lesion monthly and consult a doctor if the mole has<sup>2</sup>:



## (A)SYMMETRY

Two halves that don't match



### (B)ORDER

An uneven border



### (C)OLOR

Multiple shades of tan, brown, or black; or unusual colors such as red, purple, or blue



### (D)IAMETER

A diameter longer than 6 mm (about the size of a pencil eraser)



### (E)VOLUTION

A different size, shape, or color over time
